1. Get a website

Build your reputation by giving your ideas away for free. Distill your days into "how-to" articles. Look for the positive aspects of every situation. Teach by sharing your life experience. When you have a realization about yourself, translate it into an article that can help someone in a similar situation.

Your job is to feel good.

To make money at your job, teach others how to feel good.

3. Get Paid

Once you have a solid reputation as an uplifting, inspiring teacher, start making things to sell. Lots of things. A new thing a week. You don't know what people will buy from you. You don't know how to sell them things yet. But if you try something new every week, you'll learn fast.

- Make your life easy by selling *digital products*. Ebooks, videos, and audio are good examples. You only have to make the product once and then you have unlimited inventory.
- Use *PayPal buttons* to make the purchasing process easy for yourself and your audience.
- Set up a *free mailing list* with Mailchimp and give your audience an incentive to sign up for it. Then you have a targeted list of people to advertise your products to.

- While you're making things to sell, set up some *passive income streams* like Google Adsense or a blip.tv account for your videos.
- Set up an *affiliate program*. Find a product you love that you think your audience would be interested in buying. When someone buys that product by clicking the link on your site, you get a cut. I sell Bluehost webhosting because it's the company I use to host my sites.

Remember, your goal is to teach people ways to feel good. Your best content should be free so they trust that you know what you're doing. But your audience will pay for shortcuts to feeling good. Not everyone has time to read every article on your site.

Collect and synthesize your absolute best ideas and create products from them.

Your products should either save your audience time or give them a mind-blowing enjoyable experience. Attention is our most precious resource, so either don't require too much of it or make sure it's focused on something that feels really good.

When you genuinely help your audience feel good, their lives will improve. Good feelings attract good experiences. When you help someone's life improve, you have a customer for life.

You purchased this product because you want to get paid doing what you love. All you need to do to make that happen is believe in yourself. Make the leap of faith that this will work for you and never look back. You are a brilliant, creative individual who has something unique to share with the world that others will pay to experience. The only thing holding you back from success is you!

3.1 Let Go
